

## Language requirements for the EUR-Organic

Language tests and minimum requirements (in brackets) accepted for first admission at all universities:

- IELTS (6.5)
- Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE)

Additional language tests and minimum requirements accepted for first admission per university:

### University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna (BOKU):

- BOKU's English III course (B2)
- Austrian School Leaving Exam (English at Matura)
- TOEIC (785 points)
- Cambridge Business English Certificate (BEC higher)

An official proof of language skills is not requested from applicants whose native language is English or who have already completed a study programme in English.

An official proof of language skills is not requested from the following applicants:

- “Native speakers” from the following countries: United Kingdom, Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, United States of America, as well as from the Caribbean States Antigua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Dominica, Grenada, Jamaica, St. Kitts, St. Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago and from South America Belize and Guyana

Applicants that completed a Bachelor's or Master's programme in English language at an accredited university of the European Union or in one of the countries listed above.

**Aarhus University (AU):**

English language qualifications comparable to an 'English B level' in Denmark can be documented as follows:

- **TOEFL:**  
*English B* – Test result of at least 560 (paper-based) or 83 (internet-based)  
The Aarhus University TOEFL code is 8935.  
*Please note: Aarhus University does not accept the TOEFL ITP test.*
- **IELTS:**  
*English B* – Test result of at least 6.5 point
- **Cambridge ESOL examinations**  
*English B* – Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) or First Certificate with grade A as a minimum.  
*Please note: from 2017 only grades A, B or C are accepted. Applicants must upload their Confirmation of Entry stating candidate ID number and candidate secret number, which are not stated on the test result itself.*
- **CEFR validated English language course**  
*English B* – C1 level

An official proof of language skills is not requested from the following applicants:

- **"Native speakers" with an English language qualifying exam** (including applicants with a qualifying examination from USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Great Britain, Scotland, or Ireland).  
*Please note: Applicants with a qualifying examination from all other countries (including African and Asian countries, where the exam has been taught in English) must submit a test.*
- **Applicants holding a Danish/Nordic/Duborg/[International Baccalaureate \(from the IB diploma programme\)](#)/European Baccalaureate (from the "ScholaEuropaea") entrance examination** with an English level which is considered comparable to a Danish B level in English by the Danish Agency for International Education. [See a comparison of the Nordic subject levels.](#)
- **Applicants with an English language Bachelor's or a Master's degree from USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Great Britain, Scotland or Ireland.** The applicant must document that the programme was taught in English.
